- ☐ I link parallel actions with while and keep stative verbs like know, want, need in the past simple.

<i>"Everyone" counts as singular → was; the scene was running when I arrived.</i></p> |

<i>"We" takes were, not was.</i></p> <p>02 She was preparing her notes before the meeting.
<i>After was/were the main verb needs the -ing form: "preparing".</i></p> <p>03 He wanted a coffee during the meeting.
<i>"Want" is a stative verb and stays in the past simple.</i></p> | <p>04 While we were updating the app, the server went down.
<i>Before a full clause with subject and verb use "while"; "during" comes before a noun.</i></p> <p>05 I was working on the report all morning.
<i>The form needs both bricks: "was" + "working".</i></p> <p>06 I was packing my suitcase when the taxi arrived.
<i>The interrupting short event takes the past simple: "arrived".</i></p> |
